



Sunwing Code of Conduct

Sunwing Airlines are proud to provide your flight to Nassau, Bahamas, and your return to Newark.

In order to ensure a safe and secure flight, the following Security conditions will be in place, and enforced, for the duration of the time you are on the aircraft.

1. Passengers must follow the instructions given to them by any crew member.
2. You will remain in your assigned seat for the duration of the flight, other than to use the rest room.
3. Should there be any more than 2 people waiting in line to use the rest room, please remain in your seat until that number goes down.
4. At all times, you will respect your fellow passengers and refrain from participating in any activity or behaviour, that would spoil their enjoyment of the flight.
5. At no time will any passenger enter the forward or aft galley, under any circumstances.
6. At no time will passengers misuse or interfere with any equipment on the aircraft, including the communication system, life jackets, oxygen masks and smoke detectors.
7. The use of the following is strictly prohibited:
 - a) Cigarettes or any other tobacco related products
 - b) E-cigarettes
 - c) Consumption of alcohol
 - d) Consumption of narcotics
 - e) Swearing, gestures or any other method of profanity that will cause upset to other passengers and the crew.
 - f) Harassment of any kind towards other passengers or crew.
8. Passengers must strictly adhere to all policies, procedures, rules, and regulations of the aircraft operators

If any Passenger fails to abide by the conditions above, and/or engages in conduct that Sunwing Airlines deems improper, the responsible individuals will be reprimanded up to and including the diversion of the aircraft to the first available airport, in order to deplane the responsible individual(s).
